

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT LUNCH PROGRAM

A lunch order form will be sent home on a monthly basis. This form is a two-part form. On the left side of the paper, please fill in your child's name and grade. Please put a check in front of the lunches you want to order. If your child wants a double order of a lunch, put a 2 on the line in front of that choice. There are alternate lunches (hot dog and peanut butter and jelly sandwiches) available for those children who may not like the lunch for that day. Please put HD or PBJ on the line instead of a check if you want to order the hot dog or peanut butter and jelly sandwich. **LUNCHES ARE NOW \$2.60 EACH.** The right side of the form should also be filled out, **cut and kept at home** to refer to on a daily basis. Please make checks payable to **SJRA LUNCH PROGRAM.** Please return the left side of the lunch order form and the check in the plastic zipper bag.

LUNCH ORDERS MUST BE SENT IN BY THE RETURN DATE ON THE FORM. Late orders were beginning to be a problem last year and we need you to promptly send back the form so supplies may be ordered. **If this continues to be a problem, we will not be able to accept any late orders.** If your child will be absent more than a day, you need to **call the order in to the school.**

MILK ORDER ENVELOPES SHOULD BE PAID SEPARATELY FROM THE LUNCH ORDER

Some examples of lunches are:

MONDAY – Pizza Hut or Tommy's Pizza and veggies

TUESDAY – McDonalds cheeseburger, or 4pc chicken nuggets, french fries or apples, cookies
OR Tommy's Cheese steaks or Chicken cheese steaks OR
Subway – Ham & Cheese or Turkey and Cheese deli sandwiches, chips
We will again offer 6" subs for an additional \$1.00 per sub (the total price would be \$3.50 for that day's lunch). Choices may be Meatball, Subway Club, BMT, Chicken Teriyaki, etc.

WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY & FRIDAY

Lunches are prepared in school. In addition to the lunch entree, dessert will be served. Fruit, pudding, jello. Salad, soup (in colder weather) will be served as often as possible.

Chips and ice cream novelties are sold during lunches. Most selections are \$.50 or .75 each.

Lunches are pre-ordered, so if you did not order, be sure to send in a lunch. Every child is expected to have a lunch. If the lunch is forgotten, you will be called to see if lunch can be brought to school. If lunch cannot be brought to school in time for the lunch period, the child will be given a hot dog or PB&J. You will be asked to send in \$2.60 the next day to pay for lunch.

LUNCHROOM MONITORS ARE NEEDED FOR ABOUT 1-1/2 HOURS A DAY. If you are available and willing to volunteer your time, please call the office (325-3186) or send in a note. We are hoping for at least two parents per day. This would be done on a strictly volunteer basis.

Wednesday – HOT SOFT PRETZELS will be sold for the morning snack for \$.50 each.
Money will be collected that day.

LUNCH ROOM RULES

Each teacher will have a monthly master sheet for their class for lunches ordered. Teachers will bring their class to the lunchroom and have them divided into two groups: Those who ordered lunch and those who brought a bag lunch. The 1st door of the lunchroom will be for those who ordered lunch. All other students will use the back door. Drinks should be picked up before lunch and given out in the classroom. If a student does not have a lunch, they should be sent to the office in the morning to call home. If a lunch cannot be brought to school in time for their lunch period, a hot dog or PB&J will be provided. The student must bring in \$2.60 the next day.

Any student who needs a lunch warmed in the microwave is asked to wait politely, off to the side, until all students who ordered lunch are served. This is a privilege that Ms. Green is willing to extend, but you must remember she is only one person and you must be patient.

Students should arrive at the lunchroom in silence and not talk until they are seated. This is a big help since the lunch ladies are preparing to distribute the lunches and are not in the hallway. Students should get everything they need for lunch before they sit down.

No one is permitted to leave the lunchroom without permission for any reason. Students are to ask an adult before leaving to go the restroom/nurse etc. Students must sit at their assigned tables, feet down and facing the table. Students are expected to speak in quiet voices, **NO YELLING OR SCREAMING.** After students are finished with their lunches, they are allowed to purchase ice cream or chips. Students will clear their places when they are finished eating, picking up anything that fell on the floor or chair. Each student is responsible for leaving the table clean like it was when they first sat down. **NO FOOD/CHIPS/ICE CREAM IS ALLOWED TO BE EATEN OUTSIDE THE LUNCHROOM.**

IF THE LIGHTS ARE TURNED OFF, ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE SILENT!

ANY THROWING OF FOOD, TRASH, OR BELONGINGS, INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR, DISRESPECT, ANSWERING BACK TO ANY ADULT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

When lunch is over, students are to be silent and wait for their table to be called to line up. Be sure to clean up the table and floor, push in the chairs and leave the lunchroom in silence.

NO STUDENTS ARE PERMITTED BEHIND THE SERVING TABLE IN THE KITCHEN AREA AT ANY TIME, BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER SCHOOL.

After lunch, students will either go outside for the remainder of their lunch period or to their classrooms depending on the weather/special circumstances. If the students go outside, they are expected to socialize not run around or play ball, etc. If the students go to their classrooms, they are expected to speak quietly, read a book, or do a quiet activity. Other classes are still working, so please be considerate of them.

If there is a problem during lunch, the student should speak to a parent in the lunchroom or ask permission to see Mrs. Salovay.
